An early 20th century silver cased keyless wind open-faced gentleman's chronograph pocket watch, the unsigned jewelled movement numbered '1208402', the white enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals, two subsidiary dials and centre stop seconds, with silver inner case, the case back with engine turned decoration, London 1920, total weight 84.3g, case diameter 4.8cm.

Condition Report

1063. The watch is in good clean condition with only typical light surface scratches. The watch winds and adjusts smoothly and chrono feature in good working order, with centre stop seconds, starting, stopping and return to zero as it should. Good clear hallmarks.
