### LOT 1157

A George III mahogany cased stick barometer, the silvered dial with vernier scale and alcohol thermometer and inscribed 'A.P. Tarone & Co, No. 7 Grevill StrT, Leather Lane, London', the line inlaid case with breakarch pediment above a glazed door, mercury tube and turned cistern cover, height 96cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

### Condition Report

1157. The case is in generally good condition commensurate with age. Hinged door and glass panel in good order. Cracked and repaired cistern cover. Brass mount holding mercury tube missing one screw. Typical scuffs and scratches. Silvered dial a little dirty and some minor wear. Alcohol thermometer working. The barometer has a cap in the mercury about 3/4 of the way down the tube and does not appear to be in working order.
