A late 19th century French ormolu and Sèvres style porcelain mantel clock with eight day striking movement, the backplate detailed 'T.A. Simpson 154 Regent Street', the rectangular porcelain dial with black Roman hour numerals above a scene of a courting couple, all within pale green and gilt embellished borders, detailed 'T.A. Simpson London', the classical case with urn surmount above a pair of porcelain side panels painted with musical instruments and flowers, flanked by a pair of foliate scroll supports, on an acanthus leaf and guilloché moulded rectangular base with toupie feet, height 33.5cm, with pendulum, winding key, glass dome and ebonized stand.

Condition Report

1155. The clock is in generally good cosmetic condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear.

Both trains of the movement wind, the strike mechanism is in working order, but it is not currently running. Glass dome in good condition.
