A Favre Leuba Genève Sea Sky stainless steel cased gentleman's chronograph wristwatch, Ref. 33033, circa 1960s, with signed Valjoux 72 caliber manual wind movement, the signed black dial with three silvered subsidiary dials, centre stop seconds and outer telemeter and tachymeter scales, the case with rotating bezel, the signed case back numbered '33033' and '845', case diameter 4cm, on a black rubber strap.

## Condition Report

1030. The watch is in generally good condition commensurate with age. Typical surface scratches and wear to case and crystal/glass. Dial in generally good order but some minor surface corrosion visible under x10 magnification. Bezel turns smoothly and crown screws down tightly on to case.

The movement winds and adjusts smoothly, chrono features in working order and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
