A George III mahogany stick barometer, the silvered dial with vernier scale and alcohol thermometer and inscribed 'Chas Aiano Fecit', the case with breakarch pediment and turned finials, the hinged door and trunk with inlaid decoration, the visible mercury tube above a square cistern cover, height 101cm.

Condition Report

1173. The case is a bit tired with scuffs, typical wear, minor chips and losses to inlay but otherwise generally ok. Would benefit from a gently clean and polish. Silvered dial ok with typical light wear and scratches. Mercury tube is intact but a little loose in its mount. It is missing quite a lot of its mercury from the tube (approx half full) and it is not currently working.
