A Victorian mahogany framed Robinsons Patent campaign bed with hinged and caned panels, on turned baluster legs, bearing maker's stamps 'Robinsons Patent Ilkley Yorks', height 33cm, length 193cm, depth 55.5cm.

Condition Report

2020. All parts present and correct, apart from the head rest, as there are two screw holes on either side of the frame.

The caned panels are reasonable, but there are some minor breaks to a few areas of all of the panels. It appears to have previously had panels attached over the top of the caning as there are small pins and pin holes around the edges.

The legs, naturally, are a little wobbly, but generally the frame is ok, with some overall minor scuffs, scratches and marks. The legs do still un-screw and are intact, and the frame does fold up.
