LOT 526

A gold, emerald and diamond cluster ring, mounted with the square cut emerald within a surround of six cushion shaped diamonds, otherwise with beaded shoulders, weight 2.4g, unmarked, ring size approx P1/2.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

The ring is possibly a marriage.

The cluster has been attached to the shank slightly askew, which appears odd. Whether it started life as part of another ring or something else we cannot say.

The shank has been resized in the past.

The ring appears to have been overgilded, as in some areas it has rubbed away revealing a rosy gold colour.

We have not tested the ring, but would suggest it may be 9ct gold with overgilding.

Stones appear secure in their settings.

Diamonds are a good match, sparkly but a little steely in colour. Emerald is a good colour, but quite small. All stones with typical surface abrasions and inclusions.

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
