### LOT 389

A mid-20th century Danish .925 sterling silver and enameled condiment set by Egon Lauridsen, Copenhagen, comprising salt, pepper caster of mushroom form and salt spoon, each enameled with a white seven pointed star against a pale blue ground, height of caster 4.5cm, cased, together with two pairs of silver sugar tongs and a silver mustard spoon, total weight 133.4g.

### Condition Report

389. The sterling and enamel set is in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. No significant scratches or wear. All with the same marks so would suggest it is a complete set. No other inscriptions or initials.

Both pairs of sugar tongs have part marks, the beaded pattern pair with lion passant and 'GS' maker's mark.

The other other pair with lion passant and 'GS' maker's marks.

Both with typical surface scratches and wear, the beaded pattern with slightly damaged scalloped bowls and engraved initials. The other pair in generally good order.

Mustard spoon approx 11.4cm long

Bead pattern tongs approx 14cm long

Other pair approx 13cm long
