Condition Report

340. Larger caddy - generally good condition with good crisp decoration, typical light surface scratches and wear. Engraved crest and monogram to opposing cartouches. Good clear marks to base and part mark to cover.

Pair of caddies:

Caddy 1 - essentially same condition as above, with same engraved crest and monogram to opposing cartouches. Good clear marks to base and part mark to cover.

Caddy 2 - in the same condition as above, with same engraved crest and monogram. The lid has a later Victorian mark, so has been matched.
