A white gold, platinum, sapphire and diamond ring, claw set with an oval cut sapphire between two old cut cushion shaped diamonds, detailed '18ct & Pla', weight 2.5g, ring size approx M.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

The ring has been re-shanked.

The majority of the claws have been re-tipped. The stones appear secure within their settings at present.

When viewed under a 10x loupe, there is a sizable surface reaching fracture to one of the diamonds, and the other has a chip directly beneath one claw.

The sapphire has some wear to the pavilion but this is only noticeable when viewed under a loupe.

Otherwise typical light surface scratching to the metal overall.
