An Edwardian 18ct gold, opal and diamond ring, mounted with three opals alternating with two diamond three stone divisions, Birmingham 1909, weight 5.2g, ring size approx Q1/2.

Estimate: £250 - £300

Condition Report

Generally heavy abrasion to the surface of the opals.

Both circular opals have a small chip to their sides, largely only noticeable when viewed under a loupe.

One or two claws supporting the stones are showing signs of wear, others look to have been re-tipped in the past.

The ring has been resized in the past.

Typical light scratching to the metal overall.
