A Victorian silver mounted cut glass lemonade jug of tapering cylindrical form, the silver collar and hinged tappit lid engraved with bright-cut decoration, flanked by a mask spout and reeded foliate scroll handle, London 1882 by William Hutton & Sons, height 29cm.

## Condition Report

345. The jug is in generally good condition. Silver with minor surface scratches and wear, but nothing of any real significance. Engraving is crisp and hallmarks are clear. The only damage to the silver is some loss to the top of the thumbpiece and where the thumbpiece has been pushed into the lid slightly (presumably when the damage to the top of thumbpiece occurred). Hinge is good and closes flat. Glass in good condition with no cracks and no significant chips.
