## LOT 1475

An Italian Giovanni Battista Viero Nove faience table oil lamp, late 19th century, the ribbed, waisted body painted with a floral panel in purple camaïeu surrounded by other flowers and foliage, the shoulders with three relief grotesque masks, raised on spreading scroll feet, the removable pottery reservoir with three floral panels within scroll frames, fitted with a Ditmar burner, brown painted factory mark to base, height to top of burner 43cm.

Estimate: £50 - £80

## Condition Report

In good condition overall with no restoration or cracks.

There are some small chips/fritting around the top rim outer edge of the main body and similar to the relief tops of the grotesques, fairly inconsequential in the grand scheme of things.

The burner mechanism needs attention and is not guaranteed to be working.
