An early Samuel Herman studio glass vase, dated 1967, the cobalt blue body dispersed with air bubble inclusions, striated colour to the shoulders, neck and rim, of abstract shape with uneven surface, engraved marks to base 'Samuel Herman 1967 London #3', height 13.5cm.

Condition Report

This piece was consigned by a local person who had acquired it as part of a house clearance some years ago and they had kept it as they liked the colour, only recently realising it was a signed piece.

In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or repairs. There is typical wear/scratches to the underside commensurate with age and where the vase stands on a flat surface, there are a few other surface scratches to the main body, two slightly more noticeable on closer inspection - one running horizontally approx 1cm long and the other vertically approx 2cm long.
