A Charles Vyse pottery figure of The Lavender Girl, circa 1921, modelled standing holding a lavender bunch in her right hand and a basket of lavender in her left, blue painted 'CV' monogram, 'Chelsea' and dated '1921' to base, height 22cm (restoration to body).

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

Overall fine crazing to the glaze.

Professional restoration to approximately half of the base around the right hand side edge, similar restoration to the lower right arm/wrist and to a hairline running from behind the basket across the front of the girl's tummy.

There is a small chip to the underside of the lavender poking out the front of the basket, only really noticeable when the figure is inverted.

Some flaking to blue enamel of cloak on back of figure.
