LOT 1507

A large matched pair of Royal Delft De Porceleyne Fles vases and covers, one dated 1947, the other circa 1970, the ribbed bodies of bulbous shape above octagonal lower halves, painted in shades of blue with two birds standing beneath a densely blossomed tree flanked by other flowers and foliage, above a panelled border of stiff leaves, the covers of domed shape, blue painted and incised marks to bases, heights 49cm and 47cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

Older vase crazed overall, younger vase with some crazing but not to such a great extent.

Older vase with two approximately 3cm long vertical haircracks to the top rim, mostly disappearing amidst the crazing but visible to the neck interiors mainly, and two small chips/frits to underside edge of flange of cover.

The older vase has a creamier glaze in comparison to the younger example.
