LOT 1420

A George Jones majolica strawberry server, circa 1875, modelled as a wooden trug with removable sugar and cream holders to each end, the handle formed from moulded branches entwined with strawberry leaves and fruits being pecked at by two blue tits, model No. 3423, impressed monogram mark to base and moulded diamond registration lozenge, height 20cm, length 36cm (some faults).

Estimate: £200 - £400

Condition Report

Overall fine crazing to the glaze.

Both birds missing ends of each wing otherwise minor nibbles/chips to the extremities, e.g., to one of the relief leaves, two of the branch support tops, one to the corner of the trug and another to one of the apertures.

Sugar and cream removable pots - both also crazed, one with small vertical haircrack to rim which is fairly inconsequential, the other is badly cracked with some small chips along its top rim edge.
