LOT 1589

A Spode Copeland's China Rutland design part dessert service, first half 20th century, decorated with floral panels within gilt foliate scroll frames against an apple green ground, comprising nine plates, diameter 23.5cm, and two oval dishes, together with nine Wedgwood dessert plates with scalloped rims, gilt and enamelled with floral garlands and medallions within cobalt blue panels gilt with a scale pattern, diameter 21cm, a Coalport Green Dragon pattern part service, including nine teacups and saucers, nine small plates, milk jug and sugar bowl, and four Wedgwood Keith Murray designed straw yellow colour mugs, height 12.3cm (faults).

Estimate: £60 - £80

Condition Report

Rutland - five of the plates are ok with some minor scratches, four of the plates are crazed and of these two are also stained. The two dishes are generally ok with light scratches, nothing untoward.

Wedgwood - 4 of the plates have small chips or cracks, the others are ok but with varying degrees of wear primarily to the central medallion gilding.

Coalport - one saucer heavily crazed with starcrack, otherwise all generally in good condition with some varying to shade of green colour overall.

Mugs - one ok with crack to footrim, one with chip and small nick to footrim, one with chip and nicks to footrim, only one in good condition overall.
