A Meissen relief moulded charger dish, circa 1900, painted to the centre with a group of cherries against a bright blue ground moulded in low relief with four floral panels within scroll framing heightened in gilt, underglaze blue crossed swords mark to base with other impressed, incised and painted marks, diameter 27.3cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Rings nicely when tapped.

Tiny chip and associated crack to upper rim edge at approx 4 o'clock - just visible in image one on our website using the zoom function. It is quite small and only noticeable on closer inspection as it is amongst the moulded gilt detail.

Otherwise the dish is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is typical minor rubbing to the gilt high points commensurate with age and handling.
