A Continental porcelain oval plaque, late 19th century, painted with a half-length portrait of Beatrice Cenci, believed originally to be after Guido Reni but now probably after Ginevra Cantofoli, held within a gilt softwood and gesso foliate and shell frame, plaque height 8cm, dimensions of frame 22cm by 19cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

The plaque in situ would appear to be in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There are a couple of incredibly minor and light scratches only noticeable on VERY close inspection. The frame on one side has glued repairs - these are primarily visible to the reverse.
