Condition Report

Typical overall fine crazing to the glaze with a number of small manufacturing blemishes/air bubbles to the glaze.

No cracks, chips or restoration.

Around the top part of the footrim and outer edge of the footrim the glaze has a considerable amount of blemishes/adhesions to its surface, some are white and appear to scratch off, others are dull grey in appearance and seem to cover the shiny glaze leaving a dull appearance to its surface. Please see the last two images on our website using the zoom function. I can't say if these will disappear with professional cleaning.
