### LOT 1834

An Erik Höglund Kosta Boda stamped glass bowl or dish, originally designed circa 1957, the dark amber coloured glass of dished rectangular shape with the motif of a female nude, indistinct incised mark to base, length 18cm, together with five other pieces of Erik Höglund glass, comprising a flint circular dish stamped with a half length female nude, diameter 11cm, a turquoise glass vase, height 12.5cm, and matching jug, height 11.3cm, a stemmed goblet, height 13.5cm, and a grey tinted circular bowl with tiny air bubble inclusions, diameter 21.5cm, various engraved marks to bases.

### Condition Report

Each item in the lot is in good condition overall with no damage or repairs. There are typical wear marks to the underside of the items, commensurate with age and handling. The two stamped dishes have light surface scratches to the wide rims, nothing untoward and fairly inconsequential.
