### Condition Report

Cockerel with chips to 3 corners.

Owl with tiny nicks to 2 corners.

Tiger with small horizontal haircrack from edge to bend of tail.

Mouse with glued repair to one corner and a number of nicks to edges.

Lion with haircrack to top left corner and lots of chips to edges, primarily visible to underside with small nicks to upper edges.

Robin with tiny nick to one corner.
