A George IV 18ct gold cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch with fusee movement, the backplate detailed 'London', the gilt dial with engine turned centre, applied Roman hour numerals and outer floral border, the case with engine turned decoration within foliate borders, London 1829, total weight 93.7g, case diameter 4.5cm.

1001. The watch is generally in good cosmetic condition with typical light surface scratches and wear to case and crystal. Hinges are good and close tightly. Dial in good order with typical light scratches and wear. Very small dent to case back.

The watch is not running.

No removeable brass dust cover, it has an integral gold cover.
