An early 20th century Swiss Orama Etonia Lever silver circular cased gentleman's trench wristwatch with unsigned jewelled lever manual wind movement, the signed white enamelled dial with luminous Arabic hour markers and subsidiary seconds, the case with 'Telephone Dial' shrapnel guard, the case back interior detailed '0,925', case diameter 3.5cm, on a black leather strap.

The dial is generally good but there is a faint hairline running from the 3 o'clock across to the subsidiary seconds dial.

Case with typical light surface scratches and wear. Small dent to case back. Hinge is good and front cover in good order. Replacement winder.

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
