An early 20th century silver cased keyless wind open-faced gentleman's chronograph pocket watch, the unsigned jewelled movement detailed 'Swiss Made' and numbered '174762', the white enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals, two subsidiary dials and centre stop seconds, the silver inner case with engraved presentation inscription, import mark London 1919, total weight 80.4g, case diameter 5cm.

Condition Report

1083. Generally good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear to case and glass. Dial in generally good condition with some minor scratches. Hinges are good, Engraved presentation inscription to back of inner case.

The movement winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

The chrono is working with start and stop but returns to about 1minute past 12 rather than perfectly upright.

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
