A Rolex Oyster Perpetual Datejust 18K gold and aftermarket diamond and ruby set mid size bracelet wristwatch, Ref. 6827, circa 1981, with signed and jewelled movement, the signed red Stella type dial with gilt detail, diamond set hour markers and date aperture, the case with later diamond and ruby set bezel, numbered between the lugs '6827' and '6557683', Rolex crown to winding button, the tapered link bracelet with signed foldover clasp, detailed '750 18K', total weight 92.4g, case diameter 3cm.

Condition Report

1100. The watch is in generally good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage or repairs. Dial in good condition with no cracks or damage.

The glass/crystal is cracked between the centre and 6 o'clock (visible in the online images).

The diamonds and rubies are bright and sparkly.

The crown screws down tightly.

the bracelet is in good order with only little stretch and clasp in working order.

The movement winds and adjust smoothly, date rolls over as it should and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
