A late 19th/early 20th century brass and green marble four glass mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a gong, the white enamelled chapter ring with black Roman hour numerals framing an engine turned centre, above an imperial eagle pendulum, the case with Ionic columns and bevelled glass panels, on a stepped base and bun feet, height 33.5cm.

### Condition Report

1181. The case is a little dusty and dirty but generally ok. Both pillars have been repaired. typical wear and surface scratches to brass and marble. Typical small chips to corners of glass panels but nothing too significant. Dial has hairline cracks. The clock is not currently running.
