A 19th century Black Forest mahogany octagonal cased drop dial wall clock, the eight day movement with wooden plates striking on a gong, the 9-inch painted circular dial with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'Wehrle Cambridge', the octagonal surround with brass inlaid decoration, the bowed apron with glazed lenticle, case width 31cm, with pendulum.

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

1202. Case is ok but needs a little attention. Typical scratches and wear on some veneer cracks to surround and one side. Brass inlay all present with some minor areas of lifting but nothing too significant. Painted wood dial is split, discoloured and worn. Glass front door is ok but catch is an adapted replacement. Both trains of the movement wind and it is currently working. Strike also works but a rather dull thud, please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
