A Jaeger-LeCoultre Atmos mantel timepiece, Ref. 528-8, circa 1970s, the signed perpetual gilt brass movement numbered '369741', the white circular chapter ring with gilt Arabic numeral and arrowhead hour markers, the lacquered brass and glazed case with canted corners, plinth base and bracket feet, height 23.5cm, width 20.8cm, together with a Jaeger-LeCoultre 'The Manufacture's Book of Timepieces' book.

Condition Report

1170. The Atmos clock in generally good condition, typical surface scratches and wear to gilt lacquer glass in good order with typical light surface scratches. The glass front panel has a tiny chip to bottom front corner but of no real significance and not noticeable when panel in place.

The movement is working and over an hour test is keeping good time but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
