LOT 1217

A George III oak longcase clock with thirty hour movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the 10-inch square brass dial with Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'Longhurst, Steyning', the hood with a moulded pediment above a glazed door flanked by columns, the trunk with a plain door above a plinth base, height 198cm, with pendulum and a weight.

Estimate: £50 - £70

Condition Report

1217. The clock is in need of some attention.

Overall it is a bit dirty and dusty, case with typical chips, scuffs and scratches, heavier wear around base and one side of base is a replacement, horizontal split across base panel and chips to front edge of base so does not stand straight (a bit wobbly).

Hinged glazed door to hood in good order. Trunk door a little warped and door lock replaced.

Dial in generally good order with typical surface scratches and wear.

Movement is dirty and would require a service/overhaul to return to working order.
