An Omega Automatic Seamaster stainless steel cased gentleman's chronograph wristwatch, Ref. 176.007, circa 1972, the signed and jewelled 1040 caliber movement numbered '34256981', the signed blue dial with two subsidiary dials, date aperture and centre stop seconds, framed by a cream tachymeter scale, the signed case back interior numbered '176.007', the case back with Seamaster emblem, case width 3.8cm, on a black leather strap with Omega buckle.

Condition Report

1060. The watch is in generally good cosmetic condition. Typical surface scratches to case, and a few more pronounced diagonal scratches to the glass/crystal including the worst at 2 o'clock.

Dial appears to be in good clean condition.

The movement winds and adjusts smoothly, date adjusts as it should from the crown, chrono feature working, and it is currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
