LOT 2200

A Regency ebonized and gilded tip-top games table, the square top decorated in overall penwork with a chequer board within a border of flowering stems, raised on a turned stem and quatreform base, height 70cm, width 44cm (some faults).

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

2200. The top has overall typical surface wear, some surface scratches and minor loss. Some of the corner stringing is missing to the edge of the top. Some slight movement to the edges of the veneered joins on the top. Otherwise the support and base appears to have been re-painted some time ago and has some evidence of scattered woodworm. The top edges of the reeded disc feet appear to have had some later resin repairs to the top surfaces as there are surface chips that show the resin underneath. The main structure of the feet are original but looks like the top surface has been re-finished with resin.
