A white gold, diamond and peridot cluster ring, claw set with the cushion shaped checkerboard cut peridot within a surround of circular cut diamonds, with split shoulders, unmarked, weight 7.7g, ring size approx P, with a case.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

In fairly good condition.

The peridot has a few small nicks to the girdle.

Diamonds all present.

The ring is largely 18ct white gold, however, a section at the back of the shank has been replaced with a section in 9ct white gold, probably when resized in the past.

Typical light scratching to the metal overall.
