A Continental gold and enamelled hinged bangle, early 19th century, the oval front opening to reveal a locket compartment, otherwise with floral and foliate varicoloured enamelled decoration, on a snap clasp, French import mark, weight 46.5g, inside width 5.6cm (faults).

Estimate: £2,500 - £3,500

Condition Report

There is a repair and reinforced section at the back of the bangle, with some evidence of solder holding an additional piece of gold in place.

There are some losses to the enamel work, particularly to the central band depicting flowers.

The glazing to the interior of the locket compartment is cracked.

The safety chain is broken at one end.
