A late Victorian silver mounted cut glass hip flask with detachable cup and screw hinged lid, Sheffield 1891 by James Dixon & Sons Ltd, height 15.5cm, and a similar smaller silver mounted cut glass hip flask with detachable cup, London 1917 by George Neal & George Neal, height 12.3cm, total weight of cups 107g.

Condition Report

361. Silver and glass hip flask - glass in good order with typical light surface scratches and wear, but no cracks, chips of significant damage. Silver cup fits well, typical surface scratches and numerous small dents around the sides. The screw hinge lid in good working order. Good clear hallmarks.

Silver, glass and tortoiseshell hip flask - glass in good order except for a tiny chip to rim. Silver cup in good order with good clear hallmarks. Screw hinged lid in good working order, closes tightly but is a little stiff.
