A Mexican silver, amethyst and turquoise bracelet, late 20th century, designed by Matilde Poulat, mounted with a central row of pyramid shaped amethysts, otherwise in a scrolling design and mounted with small turquoises, detailed 'Matl', on a snap clasp, fitted with a safety chain, weight 73.4g, length 17cm.

## Condition Report

Clasp in working order.

Some typical discolouration to some of the turquoises, when viewed under a loupe there appears to be some evidence of glue around one or two of the turquoises.

There are some minor chips to the amethysts on the high points and facet edges.

Some tarnishing in places.
