A small group of jewellery, including an early 19th century rectangular coral brooch, glazed with a hair locket compartment, an Art Nouveau brooch, designed as a portrait of a lady, detailed '800', a paste set jabot pin and a large cherry coloured imitation amber bead, possibly Bakelite, weight 51.3g.

Condition Report

Imitation amber bead:
the interior of the bead shows a swirling pattern,
Simichrome test - looks slightly red but not conclusive.
The bead does give off a slight odour when rubbed.
The bead sinks in salt solution.
approx. 4.8cm x 3.7cm
