A gilt metal mounted micromosaic bracelet, 19th century, each oval micromosaic designed as a differing classical building, on a snap clasp, length 18cm, with an associated case.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Clasp is in working order.

Some loss of gilding, particularly to the beaded links between the mosaics.

Some of the links between the mosaics are not soldered together, it would be advisable to have these soldered together if the bracelet was to be worn.

There are a few chips, nibbles, abrasion and some general scratching to the blue borders of the mosaics. The blue border is cracked on one mosaic, this is the one closest to the tongue of the clasp.

The mosaics themselves are in fairly good condition, only one appears to have a small piece missing and a chip.

This isn't hugely noticeable.

The case is in association, lacking some of its interior.
