LOT 744

A Victorian 18ct gold and diamond ring, designed as a coiled snake,, mounted with an old cut cushion shaped diamond, Birmingham 1881, weight 9.6g, ring size approx O1/2.

Estimate: £500 - £700

Condition Report

A couple of the claws holding the diamond are showing signs of wear.

The diamond is I clarity, with a number of dark inclusions visible to the naked eye.

Hallmark is clear.

There was possibly an old inscription within the shank but this has largely worn away,, a couple of deeper scratches within the shank.

Typical light scratching to the exterior but no evidence of thinning to the shank.

The ring is generally in good condition for its age.

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
