A Victorian 18ct gold, diamond and turquoise ring, designed as two entwined snakes, London 1885, weight 6.8g, ring size approx O1/2.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

Some wear and chipping to the turquoise, as well as typical discoloration.

The claws supporting both stones are showing some signs of wear.

Two sets of identical hallmarks, both looking fairly clear.

Some thinning to the shank, which is slightly misshaped.

Diamond clarity approx VS.

The ring would benefit from a clean, however there is a lot of impacted dirt surrounding the turquoise which may dislodge the stone if cleaned.

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
