Armand Godard (1883-1948) - an Art Deco cast bronze and ivory figure of an exotic female dancer, finely modelled holding her headscarf in one hand, a mirror in the other, balanced on one foot and raised on a banded onyx plinth, bearing incised signature 'GODARD', height 50cm (repair to one thumb and right side panel of plinth). Note: a non-transferrable ivory exemption certificate has been granted for the sale of this item.

Condition Report

2520. The right thumb has been badly re-glued. The right-hand panel of base has been broken and re-glued. There are minor scuffs to the ivory, some minor surface wear to high points of bronze and some minor surface nicks to the edges of the onyx base. Otherwise in good order.
