## Condition Report

2325. Small piece of enamel missing on the curl of the letter 'C' to the scrolled monogram on the front. The hinge pin is slightly mis-aligned. Overall very minor surface scratches to the base. The lid operates well and closes tightly. The glass bottle is a bit loose and probably not original and has a chip to its neck.
