A pair of Japanese cloisonné vases, Meiji period, each ovoid body finely decorated with sparrows flying above and amidst branches, flowers and grasses on a gilt speckled green ground, within finely worked simulated brocade borders to rim and foot, unsigned, height 24.6cm (minor faults).

Condition Report

1003. Vase 1 - generally good condition, body and neck/rim in good order. Small dent to footrim with some minor loss to enamel. Otherwise decoration is bright and vibrant.

Vase 2 - body and foot in good order. The rim at the top is slightly misshapen with some enamel loss to the edge by the rim and a section of turquoise enamel loss to inside of the rim. Otherwise decoration is bright and vibrant.
