A Chinese famille rose enamelled celadon ground porcelain vase, mark of Qianlong but modern, the globular body decorated with a uniform design of polychrome lotus and scrolling tendrils, the similarly decorated neck with chilong and bat pendants, flanked by a pair of moulded Buddhist lion mask handles between pink and blue ruyi-head collar and rim, iron red pseudo seal mark to base, height 47.5cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Overall light wear to the enamels and gilding particularly on high points and edges.

Surface scratches to body overall, particularly to widest part.

Small section of pink enamel missing from ruyi-head collar rim.
