A Chinese hardwood two-tier stand, late Qing dynasty, the square panelled top above carved bat and lingzhi frieze, on turned legs with claw and ball feet, height 79.5cm, width of top 41.3cm.

Condition Report

Generally in good condition, some joints a little loose, one leg with fracture/crack just below the shoulder. Small section of carved moulding missing to one frieze. Typical surface scratches, scuffs and wear. Minor nicks to feet.
