Condition Report

1133. Single crack running approx 11cm down one side of the pot, then across the diameter of the base, and then approx 12.5cm up the other side of the pot.

Typical light surface scratches and wear, a small glaze blemish, and a small firing crack to the body.

Otherwise no chips or restoration.
