A Chinese blue and white porcelain jar and cover, late Ming dynasty, of stout baluster form, painted with a design of lotus and scrolling leafy tendrils, height 34cm (repaired neck and rim of cover).

Condition Report

1024. Large section of rim broken and filler replacement (approx 2.5cm x 17cm). Other parts of the rim broken out and reglued.

Otherwise the body of the jar in generally good condition.

Typical light surface scratches to glaze.

The cover with rim repairs and overpainting, also a 2cm long hairline.
