A pair of Japanese cloisonné vases, Meiji period, each ovoid body decorated with red-capped cranes in flight on a pale blue ground, beneath a flared neck filled with dragons and tendrils, height 31.5cm (faults).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1033. Vase 1 - dent to rim. Impact dent to middle of body and numerous hairlines running out from this point. Some enamel loss to neck just below rim.

Vase 2 - 'V' shaped crack/chip near to base with some losses around edges. Numerous hairlines to the body. Neck in good order. Enamel to neck interior is quite rough. Footrim slightly misshapen.
