A pair of Japanese Satsuma earthenware two-handled bottle vases by Kusube, Meiji period, each globular body painted with opposing scenes of figures in landscapes, beneath a blue ground flared neck filled with gilt cell diaper borders, iron red and gilt signature to base, height 20.5cm (one with chip to rim), together with a pair of Japanese Imari porcelain vases, Meiji period, painted with flowers, height 24cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1032. Satsuma vase 1 - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Some wear to gilt.

Satsuma vase 2 - small chip (0.8cm x 1.3cm) to rim, otherwise good condition. Some wear to gilt.

Both Imari vases - in generally good order with no significant damage or repairs. Surface scratches and wear to gilt and enamels.
